

WEAPONS/FIREARMS BAN DESIGNATION

The Allen County War Memorial Coliseum is an instrumentality of the Board of Commissioners of the County of Allen, which is a political subdivision of Indiana. Indiana Code Section 35-47-11-1-2 prohibits the regulation of firearms, ammunition, and firearm accessories by a political subdivision. This includes the possession or carrying of a firearm on the grounds or in the Allen County War Memorial Coliseum. Because of this law, The Board of Trustees of the Allen County War Memorial Coliseum (Licensor) cannot ban the carrying of weapons, including firearms into the facility.

There is an exception to this law. This exception allows the organizer or promoter of an event, who is leasing property from a political subdivision or municipal corporation, to enforce its own rules of conduct and admission within their rental space.

This means that you, as the Licensee, have the right to allow or disallow weapons, including firearms, concealed or not concealed, in your event, at the Memorial Coliseum.

Because the choice of carrying weapons into an event is the event organizer's/promoter's/ Licensee's option, the Licensor requires this document be signed as part of the license agreement process if you desire to ban the carrying of weapons within your event rental space.

If you wish not to have weapons in your rental space, please sign and return this document indicating your decision to ban the admission of weapons, including firearms into your event.
